### SOFIA'S

The small bar at friendly Sofia's has room for a dozen regulars (on a first-name basis with the amiable waitresses), but most of the space is occupied by six booths, a smattering of tables and plastic decorative vines. A highlight for West Allis locals is the Sofia's Supreme (14-inch, \$18.25), loaded with sausage, pepperoni and generous cuts of extremely fresh green peppers, mushrooms, onions and black olives. You won't find it on the menu, but order the thick crust. The golden-brown border has a crunchy exterior and a tasty, chewy center. 7032 W. Lincoln Ave., 414-321-8600. (DM)
